

CHECKLIST

WEDDING'S AND ELOPEMENT'S

- Confirm booking with Celebrant, including date, time, location and ceremony type. (Wedding or Elopement)
 - Complete and Lodge 'Notice of intended Marriage' (NOIM)
**Must be done at least one month prior to getting married
 - Ensure your celebrant has seen your identity and eligibility documents.
 1. Evidence of the date and place of birth of both of you
Birth Certificate or a current overseas passport
 2. Current photo ID eg Drivers License, Proof of Age
 3. Evidence of any previous divorce or death of any spouse, if applicable—such as original divorce or death certificate of previous spouse
- Note: All your documents must be in English—or you must supply NAATI accredited translations if they are in another language
- And Finally after your special day - apply for your official marriage certificate
